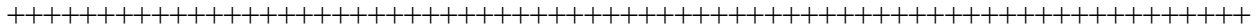

**Speakers:** **Karl Intemann:** Senior special investigator with Liberty Mutual Insurance. Karl has 33 years SIU experience, he also has 12 years criminal investigation experience with the United States Army as a CID Special Agent. Karl was a War Crimes and Atrocity investigator in Baghdad, Iraq after the initial invasion in of Iraq in 2003. Karl was awarded a Bronze Star Medal in 2004 for his efforts in Iraq. Karl holds a Bachelor's degree from the University of Michigan in History, and is currently based in Detroit, MI. He is the primary instructor and peer review leader for the Liberty Mutual crash data retrieval program.

**Dan Mero: AmFam Regional Security Officer; Eden Prairie, MN.** Dan Mero joined AmFam after 25 years as a Navy SEAL and 3 years as a contractor. During his active duty time he completed many combat deployments, along with acting as Anti-terrorism / Force Protection Officer as a collateral duty. Aside from combat deployments he was also a member of the Security Detail for Afghan President Hamid Karzai's and Senior Personnel (Flag level officers) of the Department of Defense.

**Tony Cretella:** A highly qualified Accident Reconstructionist with 25 years' demonstrated expertise and statewide reputation reflecting exceptional investigative skills; 20 years of

distinguished service with the Connecticut State Police. He has effectively served as primary investigator for 300+ investigations and assisted in more than 600, including 300+ serious injury/fatal crashes (1,000 total accidents) throughout the state of Connecticut. He achieved a Bachelor of Science degree from University of New Haven. He is also trained and experienced in crash data retrieval from onboard vehicle data recorders. He will focus on “infotainment centers” and the information that can be gleaned from them.
